# Language courses



## Language certificate


- Telc A1-C2 (European language certificates)  
Telc certificates certify language skills and are recognised by the authorities in Switzerland, by employers and by universities.
- Attest A2 oral certificate  
The competent authority in Grisons recognises the A2 oral certificate, combined with confirmation of attendance at 280 language lessons, with regard to reviews of hardship case applications.

## Requirements for more advanced language courses

You can attend a more advanced language course if you:

- Attend the course regularly (at least 80% attendance).
- Complete the homework.
- Abide by the school's rules.
- Achieve the learning objectives recommended by the teacher.
- Pass the A2 telc exam.
  - > If you achieve 48 – 60 points in the exam you can attend a B1 course.
  - > If you achieve 36 – 47.5 points in the exam you can attend an A2/B1 course.


If you have to resit the exam you will have to pay the exam fees.

# Language courses

## Courses offered/levels

Compulsory assessment test

<b>Course level</b>	<b>You ...</b>
Alpha	are unfamiliar with Latin script.
A01/02	are unable to speak any German.
A03	can only speak a little German.

<b>Course level</b>	<b>You will learn ...</b>
A1	to talk in simple sentences about subjects such as where you come from, your family, where you live, etc.
A2	to talk about your own needs and to make yourself understood in basic everyday situations.
B1	to talk coherently about familiar everyday subjects and work and to talk about your experiences.

By attending the **everyday and integration courses** you will be able to understand and make yourself understood in your daily life, if the people you are talking to speak slowly and clearly.

## Objective

- You are learning German to:
- Cope with everyday life.
  - Make friends and chat to people.
  - Get on the job ladder and gain professional qualifications.

## Childcare

Whilst the language courses are taking place (up to B1) children up to 5 years will be cared for in a playgroup.

## Travel expenses

You will be given a voucher for the cheapest ticket for travel to a course run by an external provider.
